

How to start your own 4Water project



1. Got an idea?

3. Set up classes

Think about your class organization and prices. What you charge will depend on what you're going to be teaching/exchanging and to whom you are teaching it. Generally, 4Water projects should be affordable and accessible for most people in your target population whilst charging enough to get as much water as you can! Some pricing options are pay per class, pay per day, pay per course, pay per month.
